

The True Cost of Database Downtime

Most organizations underestimate unplanned outage costs by 3-5x. This whitepaper quantifies direct and indirect costs and provides a calculation framework.

The Iceberg Effect

IT teams typically report visible costs: overtime, hardware replacement, technical fixes. These represent only 20-30% of total impact. Hidden costs — lost revenue, productivity loss, customer churn, compliance penalties, reputational damage — are far larger and often unmeasured.

Industry Benchmarks

Industry	Avg. Hourly Cost	Avg. Annual Incidents	Typical Duration
Healthcare	\$450K - \$700K	4-8	2-6 hours
Financial Services	\$500K - \$1M	2-5	1-4 hours
Manufacturing	\$100K - \$300K	6-12	2-8 hours
Retail / E-commerce	\$200K - \$500K	3-7	1-3 hours
Government	\$50K - \$150K	4-10	3-12 hours

Calculating Your Exposure

Step 1: Revenue per hour = Annual Revenue / (Business Hours x 365)

Step 2: Productivity cost/hr = (Affected Employees x Hourly Wage) x Utilization

Step 3: Direct cost/hr = Revenue Loss + Productivity Loss + IT Response Cost

Step 4: Total cost/incident = Direct Cost x Duration x Impact Multiplier (1.5-3x)

Step 5: Annual exposure = Cost per Incident x Projected Annual Incidents

Prevention ROI

Organizations investing in proactive database management — performance tuning, automated monitoring, structured backup/DR, regular health assessments — typically reduce unplanned downtime by 60-80%. At average exposures of \$500K-\$2M for mid-market organizations, prevention ROI is measured in multiples, not percentages.

Common Root Causes

Root Cause	% of Incidents	Preventable?
Storage/disk failure	25-30%	Yes — monitoring + redundancy
Query/index issues	20-25%	Yes — tuning + maintenance
Configuration errors	15-20%	Yes — change management
Security incidents	10-15%	Partially — hardening + monitoring
Hardware failure	5-10%	Partially — cloud migration

Software bugs	5-10%	Partially — patching + testing
